Whether you do the design of your PhD-thesis yourself or have it done for you, the illustrations for the inside work as well for the cover must meet certain requirements.

Reductions or enlargements can influence the quality of illustrations. Reducing a picture improves the resolution, enlarging the picture diminishes the resolution. It is not possible to improve the resolution in programs such as Photoshop or CorelDraw. This is why we recommend making the illustrations in the final book size in the program used to make the illustration. Preferably save it in TIFF or EPS, or if not possible then in JP(E)G.
